




Programme Development

# Comment Section: Summary



#### **IGF's contribution to major global initiatives**

- 1. Thematic alignment: Ensure the IGF programme and sub-themes aligns with GDC and WSIS priorities and leverage the 2025 Forum to discuss the GDC implementation and how the GDC can be integrated in the WSIS+20 review
- 2. High-Level, diversity & multistakeholder representative: Further integrate diverse stakeholders, engage more marginalized groups, and attract high-level representation in GDC and WSIS-related discussions at the IGF
- 3. Leverage of IGF's intersessional work: Collaborate with these global processes and develop policy recommendations within IGF's intersessional work that align with the GDC priorities and WSIS Action Lines
- 4. Direct IGF contributions, capacity building and awareness-raising: The IGF should directly engage in the WSIS+20 review process, support National and Regional IGFs in strengthening their ability to contribute region-specific insights to global initiatives (both GDC implementation and WSIS+20 review) and provide relevant material
- **5. UN system-wide collaboration:** The IGF, its MAG and LP to further partner with WSIS co-facilitators, UN organizations and relevant offices working on digital transformation issues to ensure coherence
- 6. Monitoring & evaluation mechanisms: establish mechanisms to track how IGF initiatives align with and contribute to GDC objectives and WSIS outcomes and dedicate sessions to report on this progress



### Comment Section: Summary



#### Overall format and design of the IGF

- 1. Audience interaction: encourage session organizers to facilitate the active participation of the audience and make more use of technology (e.g., real-time voting, gamification, collaborative drafting of documents)
- 2. Increase meaningful participation: of youth, marginalized and vulnerable groups by empowering them to submit session proposals, take active roles in IGF proceedings; Provide mentorship opportunities with established leaders
- 3. Simplify and re-design the programme: in favour of a more focused agenda by (1) establishing well-defined and specific thematic tracks, (2) redesigning the programme to be more interactive and solution-oriented, (3) limiting the number of parallel sessions and merging sessions that are overlapping thematically
- **4. Information sharing:** Share the logistics note for participants and publish the programme well in advance, widely promote the Scheduling App (e.g., via INDICO) and make use of the App to send push notifications to participants
- 5. Stakeholder representation: Considerably increase private sector representation; further integrate Parliamentary Track sessions into the IGF programme; engage international media, both as journalists and as digital stakeholders; create an "academic stream"
- **6. Develop multilingualism:** Interpret more IGF sessions into UN official languages to favour more inclusive and diverse participation, promote cultural and linguistic diversity on the programme.
- 7. **Focus on outputs:** widely promote IGF key messages and intersessional work output; at the IGF, prepare executive summaries to reflect daily outcomes of meetings; showcase practical examples of multistakeholder digital policy-making.


